Since only reporting January and February 2023 there is not much change.

New Business, Willis

- 1. <u>Bridgestone Arena Lease Update</u>, Willis, Primary point of contact at Bridgestone Arena has notified that following the lease expiration on June 30, the Hall will need to vacate the facility by December 31, 2023. Still in discussions with the organization to see if there are any possibilities to extend the timeframe without a formal lease. Called on Ezell to report on a new, long-term home for the Hall's Museum.
 - a. Discussion,
 - i. Ezell, Exploring both options, but in regards to the new location, Willis has had multiple meetings with Titan's. And, this information is publically available as it is in the current document presently before Nashville's Metro Council. If the new stadium is approved the Hall will receive space dedicated to the Museum but will need to have it's own capital campaign to build out the space. In the next three (3) to five (5) months, we will learn more as Metro considers the proposal.
 - ii. Fulmer, As we go through this period of time, there will be fundraising elements and if our membership is asked by the community we need to convey our excitement. This is a great opportunity to tell the Hall's story since the Hall is not just a building but the inductees and the growth of the organization.
