2. Clarification on Nomination Date/Process, Willis, Process will work by narrowing the field to as many as seven (7), with two (2) candidates being preferred nominees and the remaining five (5) being at-large that will require the entire Board to vote on their candidacy.

Those are the Nominees up for consideration for 2024. Open for discussion on any candidates that anyone wishes to speak on or move forward for further consideration.

# **Discussion of Nominees and Questions**

- Nomination Criteria, Discussion regarding qualified candidate back-log,
  - Fulmer, In looking back through UT records, there are many qualified candidates that have not been nominated/considered.
  - Bradshaw, Back-log of great candidates would like to give greater consideration to ones tabled in the past.
  - Willis, Two (2) procedure items: 1) Next year's class is the 60<sup>th</sup> class and the Nomination Committee is considering a larger class for the sake of celebrating and to assist with the backlog. 2) Additionally, the other halls of fame have caps, pro football is eight (8) players per year what experiencing is not an uncommon quandary to have.
  - Widrig, Since this is a persisting issue, recommend Directors present proposals with their ideas to remedy the issue and present those proposals to Willis. Willis will then include the proposals on the Agenda. The full Board can then assign the responsibility to the Nomination Committee to resolve. Willis will offer this same option during the remaining subcommittee meetings.
- Board members then went through the current and previous candidates along the biographies provided by Willis. They utilized a process whereby Members would move certain nominees forward for discussion until prepared to vote and discuss preferred versus at-large nominees.
- Carter, Regarding protocol, would like to have resolved the issue of how nominees that could fall into multiple regions be considered.
  - Widrig, recommend including that in the proposal to the Nomination committee, perhaps there is a possibility for another category and/or adding spots.
